TASTING COMMENTS

COLOUR

Deep red with purple hues.

NOSE

The nose brims with sweet lifted fruit aromas, leafy Cabernet characters and briar like, almost earthy tones.

PALATE

The palate shows good weight with generous flavours: Cabernet fruit; tobacco leaf; and spice. This is a lovely, even wine with long, dry tannins that flow right throughout the finish.
